Class Dojo & Class Pages

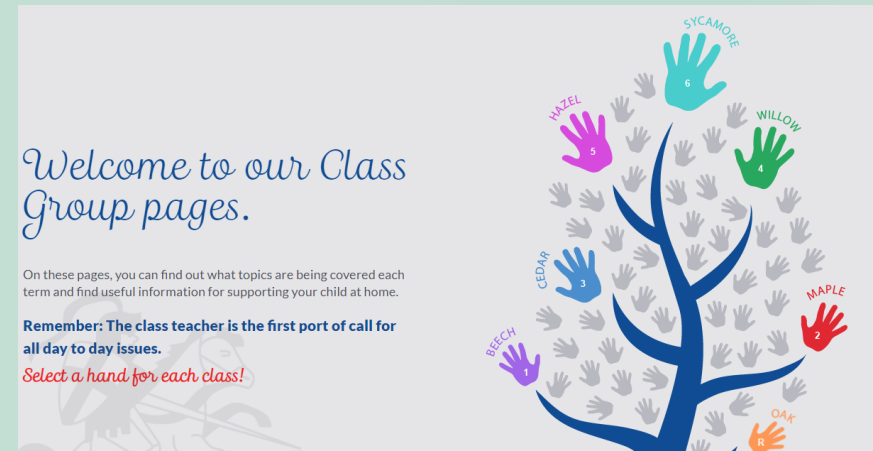
Class Dojo will continue to be used to aid communication between home and school.
