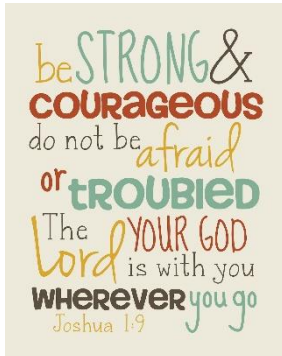


R.E. and Collective Worship Newsletter.
