

CLUBS CODE OF CONDUCT

At St George's Church of England Primary School our clubs are run by teachers, who volunteer, or approved outside providers, to enrich our school day.

We want our clubs to be fun and inclusive for everyone. We want our clubs to be a positive experience for both children and adults and where new things can be learnt in a safe environment.

As a member of St George's After School Clubs children are expected to:

- ✓ Show respect to the adults running and supporting the club and to one another
- ✓ Be on time to start the club
- ✓ Behave and listen to instructions given
- ✓ Keep within the area your club is held whether it be a classroom, hall or the school field
- ✓ Take care of any equipment you are allowed to use
- ✓ Make your club a fun place to be
- ✓ Show respect to other members of the club and team spirit bullying will
 not be tolerated
- ✓ Wear appropriate clothing as agreed by the adult leading the session
- ✓ Be committed by being on time and having regular attendance

If you cannot attend a session your parents will need to inform the office on admin@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk so the adult leading in school has an up to date register.

If two consecutive sessions are missed without informing the school, the adult in charge of this club will inform the office and your child's place will be withdrawn and allocate to another child.

If the Code of Conduct is broken by a child's behaviour or actions it may result in them being asked to leave the club.
