

Covid-19 Guidelines for Parents.

Concern	What Should I Do?	When Can They Return to School?
<p>My child has ONE or MORE of the following Covid-19 symptoms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High Temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back • A new continuous cough – this means you cough continuously for an hour or more or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual) • A loss or change to sense of smell or taste – this means you cannot smell or taste anything or things smell or taste different to normal 	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk • Get a test. Notify the school as soon as you are aware of the result • The whole household must self-isolate for 14 days 	<p>If you have a negative result contact the school by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk</p> <p>A member of the Office Team will call you to discuss your child's return</p>
<p>My child has tested positive for Covid-19</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk • The whole household must self-isolate for 14 days 	<p>Pupils can return after 10 days if they are well enough to do so but in discussions with the school, in line with our school's arrangements</p> <p>Please contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk to discuss your child's return</p>
<p>A sibling of a pupil has been sent home from school with Covid-19 symptoms</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk • Arrange for collection of son/daughter • Get a test for sibling. Notify the school as soon as you are aware of the result • The whole household must self-isolate for 14 days 	<p>Contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk</p> <p>If the sibling has a negative result, a member of the Office Team will call you to discuss your child's return</p> <p>If the sibling has a positive result, a member of the Office Team will call you to discuss your child's return which will be a minimum of 14 days</p>

<p>Someone in my household has Covid-19 symptoms</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk • Get a test for the person with symptoms. Notify the school as soon as you are aware of the result • The whole household must self-isolate for 14 days 	<p>Contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk</p> <p>If the household member has a negative result, a member of the Office Team will call you to discuss your child's return</p> <p>If the household member has a positive result, a member of the Office Team will call you to discuss your child's return which will be a minimum of 14 days</p>
<p>NHS Track and Trace has identified my child has been in close contact to someone with symptoms of Covid-19</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk • Your child must self-isolate for 14 days • Siblings and other household members need not self-isolate but must follow guidance on social distancing and hand washing 	<p>Contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk</p> <p>A member of the Office Team will contact you to discuss your child's return which will be a minimum of 14 days</p>
<p>We have received medical advice that my child must shield</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk • Shield until you are informed that restrictions have been lifted 	<p>Contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk</p> <p>A member of the Office Team will contact you to discuss your child's return</p>
<p>We/my child has travelled and has had to self-isolate as a period of quarantine</p>	<p>THE SCHOOL DOES NOT AUTHORISE HOLIDAY ABSENCES DURING TERM TIME</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk • Consider quarantine guidance and FCO 	<p>Contact the school, either by phone on 01732 882401 or email office@st-georges-wrotham.kent.sch.uk</p> <p>A member of the Office Team will contact you to discuss your child's return which will be a minimum of 14 days</p>

	<p>advice when booking travel</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The whole household must self-isolate for 14 days (if everyone has travelled) 	
<p>My child is ill with symptoms not related to Covid-19</p>	<p>FOLLOW THE SCHOOL'S USUAL ATTENDANCE PROCEDURE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact the school by phone on 01732 882401 • Please be clear about the reason for absence • If you are concerned about your child's symptoms consult with your GP as normal 	<p>Pupils can return once they feel well enough to do so</p> <p>Pupils absent with diarrhoea and sickness cannot return to school until 48 hours after the last bout</p>
