The post is a term time, fixed contract only, 15 hours a week, which will be three days a week (Monday to Wednesday) 830am-3.30pm (to include planning and preparation time). Previous experience is preferred but not essential for the right candidate.

The contract is fixed term and will have an end date of Friday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2023.

### **Essential qualities & skills:**

- An individual who has the ability to enthuse and motivate children
- A commitment to the highest standards of learning
- Relevant and recent experience of working in a school, preferably in Key Stage 1
- An ability to communicate, work as part of a successful team, take on board advice, use their initiative and meet deadlines
- An individual who is organised, efficient and flexible in their approach
- A good level of English, maths (at least NVQ level 2 or Grade C GCSE/ O' level) and a willingness to further professional development
- Proficiency in the use of ICT
- Experience in adapting and differentiating learning experiences to cater for individual needs and how to plan for and celebrate small steps of progress.
- Ideally a good understanding phonetical and language development
- Understanding of various needs including ASC, ADHD, MLD and Dyslexia (not essential but preferred)
