
DEBATING WITH THE MAYOR!

KEEPING SAFE

With some wet and cold days drawing in as autumn sets upon us please can I remind children should bring a NAMED coat to school. The children often go outside in light rain for fresh air.

Can I also advise that children both before and after school should not be on the school field or play equipment for their own safety as it can be slippery and dangerous.

It is helpful that on collection of your children you exit the school grounds as soon as possible please. Please stick to the pathways as we often use the KS2 playground for after school clubs or matches and we want everyone to be safe. Any scooters or bikes must NOT be ridden on the school site at any time.
