KS1 9.30am in the school hall

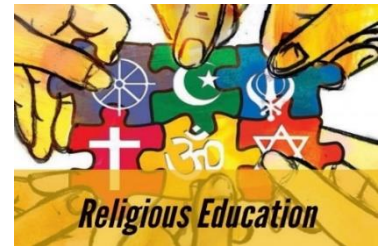
KS2 11.00am in St George's Church
