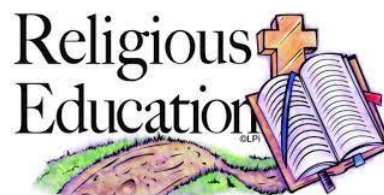
Christmas
