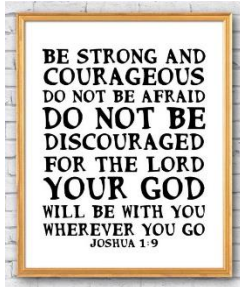




## R.E. and Collective Worship Newsletter.

(core learning)

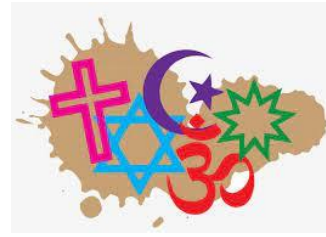
Year 2 - Why does Christmas matter to Christians? (digging deeper)
