- 1 Thessalonians 5:11



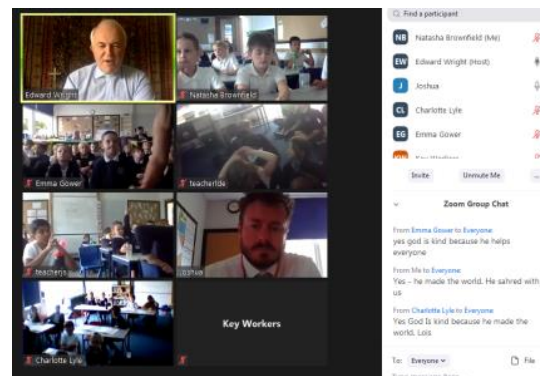
Our Value this term is Kindness. Kindness towards each other is vital and classes have investigated this during Worship time as well as in playtimes and as part of PHSE lessons.

Year 1 - What do Christians believe God is like?

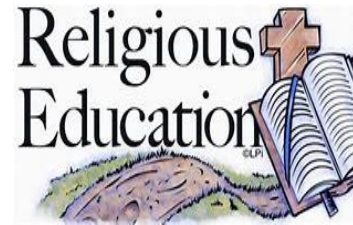
Year 2 - Who made the world?
