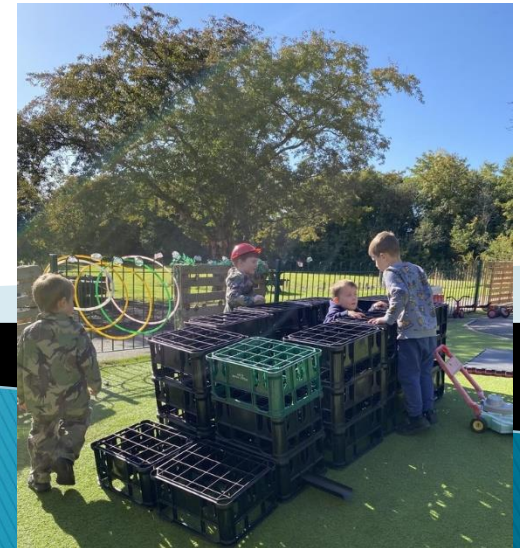

Induction

At St George's, we have a fantastic induction programme to support your child settling into school.

- ▶ Dragons Club - come along in the summer term to meet the Oak Class team and get to know your classroom.
- ▶ Parents information meeting - ideas to help you talk to your child about starting school.
- ▶ Home visits - It's so important to us to build relationships with you and your family! Before your child starts school, we come and see you at home.
- ▶ Staggered Start - half days and a gentle build up to full time.



School Uniform



- ▶ White school logo polo shirt
- ▶ Navy tracksuit bottoms or shorts (for summer)
- ▶ Navy logo hooded zip up sweatshirt
- ▶ Black Velcro/slip on trainers
- ▶ School book bag (no rucksacks please)
- ▶ Welly boots
- ▶ Waterproof trousers and jacket or all in one (to be left at school)



PE Uniform

- ▶ House coloured logo t-shirt.
- ▶ Black shorts or tracksuit bottoms
- ▶ Black Velcro/slip on trainers

Children will come dressed in their PE kit and stay in it all day.



A typical Day in Oak Class

Throughout the day, the class teacher will work with the children as a whole class, maybe on the carpet or outdoors. The children will be given opportunities to do teacher directed activities - whereby the teacher will plan activities for the children to work on with an adult, alone or perhaps in groups.

The children will also work on child-initiated activities; this is when the children can direct their own learning and can choose to explore different resources in the classroom and garden.



Lunch Time

- ▶ We are very lucky to have an onsite kitchen at St George's. Children can choose daily whether to bring a packed lunch or have a freshly prepared school hot dinner.



PE and Forest School

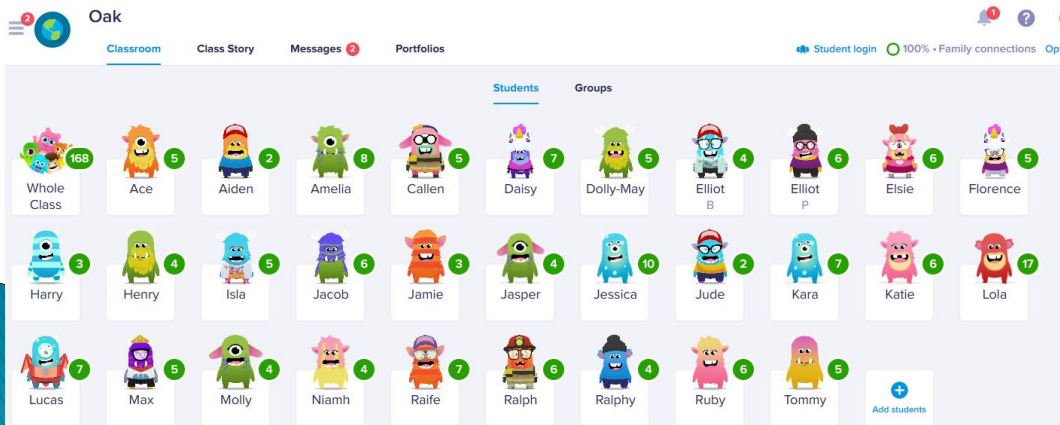
- ▶ As part of their timetable, the children will have a PE lesson in the school hall or outside.

- Communication through ClassDojo is a great interactive platform that keeps you involved daily with your child's learning.
