


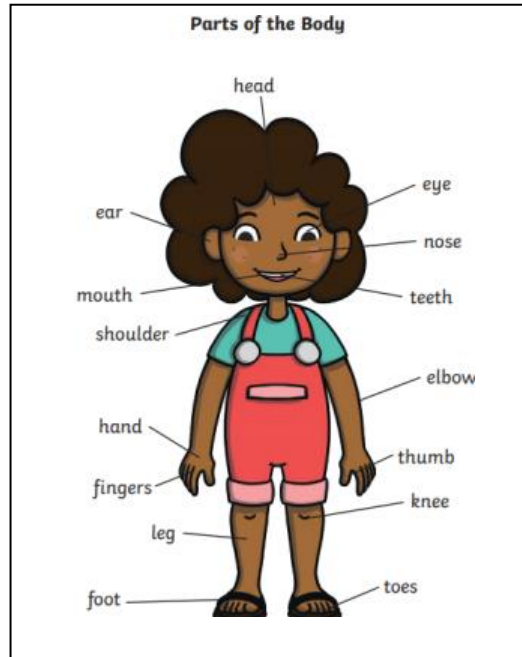
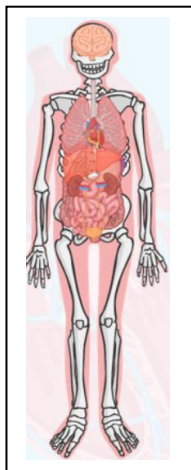






Heart		Special muscle in your body. Is found inside your chest and is protected by your rib cage.
