

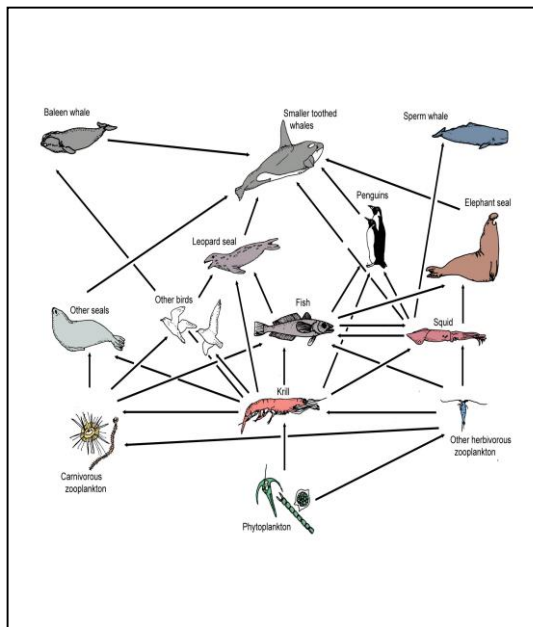
| Vocabulary | Definitions |
|------------|--|
| Extinct | None left in the world, all died out |
| Habitat | The natural home of an animal or plant |
| Prey | Animals that are eaten by another animal for food |
| Producer | A plant that makes its own food from sunlight |
| Consumer | An animal that eats plants or other animals |
| Predator | Animals that eat other animals |
| Herbivore | An animal that only eats plants e.g. cow, deer |
| Carnivore | An animal that only eats meat e.g. shark, lion |
| Omnivore | An animal that eats plants and meat, e.g. humans, badger |

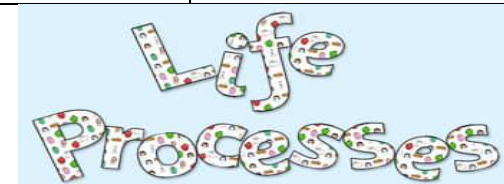
