Christian Values

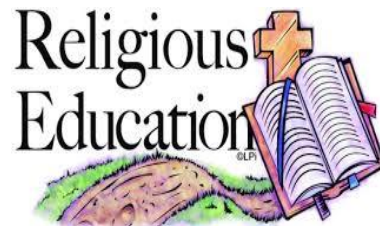
