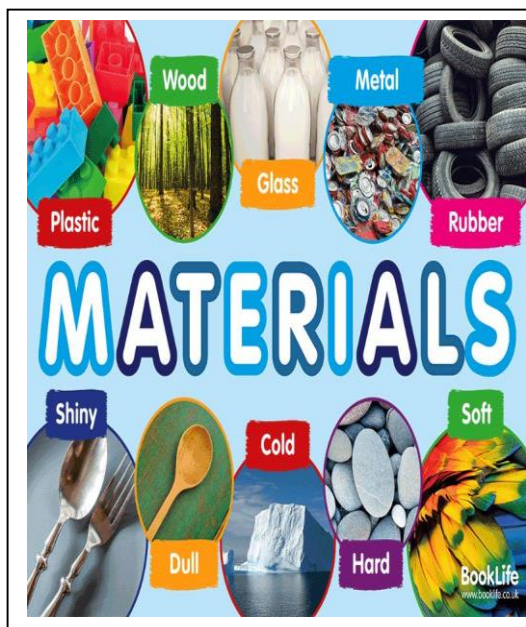

Property	Definition
Hard	Not easily broken
Soft	Easy to cut, fold or change shape
Stretchy	Can be made longer or wider without breaking
Stiff	Doesn't change shape easily
Shiny	Reflects light easily
Dull	Not very bright or shiny
Rough	Has an uneven surface
Smooth	An even surface with no lumps or bumps
Bendy	Can be bent easily
Waterproof	Keeps out water
Absorbent	Soaks up liquid easily
Transparent	Easy to see through
Opaque	Not able to see through
