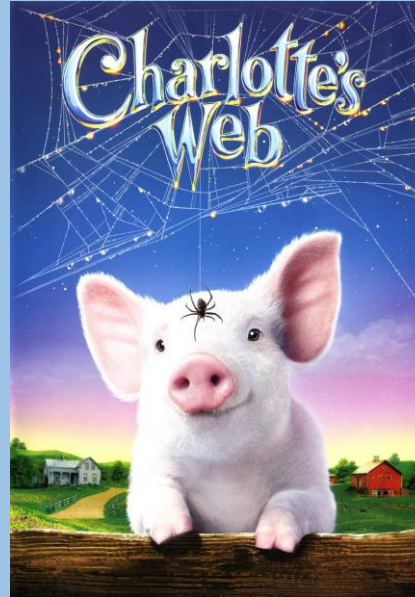
Number Facts and Place Value

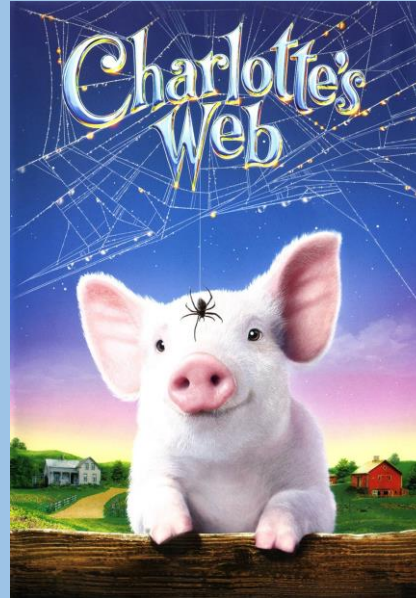

· Explore how to move in and under water

· Recognise how swimming affects breathing

· Identify and describe differences between different leg and arm actions
