Reminder

Thank you for your prompt arrival for drop off and pick up times. If you are really keen and arrive early and it crosses into another group's time slot, please be aware to social distance for everyone's confidence. Can you only bring ONE adult onto the school playground to aid this please. At this point the wearing of face coverings is your own decision while on the school grounds but please be aware of other people around you. We want EVERYONE to feel safe and confident at times where there are more adults in one area.

Can I remind everyone to park responsibly outside of school at drop off and pick up times. Please do not park on the double yellow lines or on corners as this is dangerous for pupils and adults trying to cross smaller roads safely. The school gates should be clear at ALL times for emergency vehicles only and we also use the gates for our pedestrian walk way. Please do not use or park in or over private roads as we also have a responsibility to look after our wider community.

It is everyone's responsibility to ensure our actions are for the safety of all.
