your God will be with you wherever you go

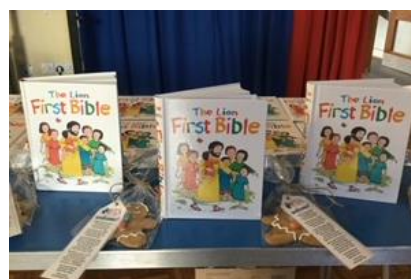
