Monday saw an invasion of scientists descend on our school as Science Week was introduced in the school hall with a series of experiments with light and explosions that created a lot of excitement. This has been followed up this week with STEM activities as house competitions and individual workshops with our visiting physicist scientist Dr Raymond. There was slime making, magnet attraction, exploring of light and electricity to name but a few things the children explored.
