Every child has received a mid-year attendance letter. Our school aims for 96% for every child to enable them to reach their full potential academically. So far this year our whole school attendance is 94.3%. An attendance above 90% is good, above 96% is OUTSTANDING. Below 90% is classed as persistent absence. Sadly, we do have a few persistent absences, which proved to be a limiting judgement in our Ofsted. However, this term alone 51% of our school achieved 100% attendace – lets work hard to move in this direction!

Reminders!

- ➤ Reporting an illness please call the school office on 01732 882401 before 9.30am if your child is unwell and unable to attend school. Please also advise the school office of any medical appointments prior to their date

- ➤ Please park responsibly and legally school coaches for educational visits and swimming are often having to stop in dangerous locations to inconsiderate parking on double yellow lines or on corners
