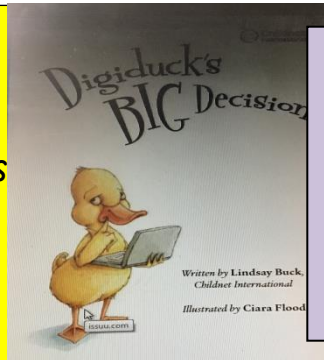


# Internet Safety in Maple Class

We read Digiduck's BIG Decision. We discussed what his big decision was and what the consequences would be for his actions.

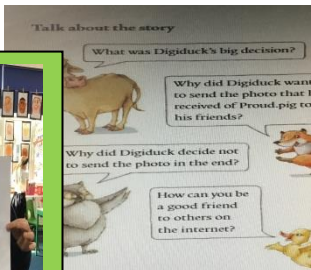


Alex – "His big decision was whether to send the photo or not."

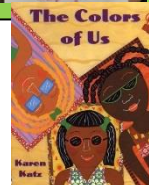
Max- "He wanted to send the funny as he wanted to cheer his friends up."
