School Priorities for academic year 2019-20

1. Attendance

We continue to monitor all attendance with our goal of improving our overall school attendance figures. Term 2 attendance reports have been sent home for each child including individual letters for 100% attendance. Communication of absence between parents and school has improved and it is hoped this will show in improved school figures.

Action:

• Continue to monitor all attendance and take the appropriate action.

2. Academic results

Purple Mash information sessions have been set up in Term 4 Week 3. Parents are encouraged to continue supporting their child's development by completing the homework focus and then using Purple Mash to consolidate learning. If parent are unable to access Purple Mash and Mathletics because they have no internet access, they are encouraged to speak to the class teachers who can offer alternative provision and support. As an alternative, local facilities eg libraries are also able to provide internet access.

Action:

• Teachers to review usage figures to ascertain what alternative support can be given.

3. Curriculum Development

We continue to make changes to our curriculum to ensure the learning on offer will engage our children and make the most of our school and the surrounding areas.

Further discussion:

- 1. We have received high feedback from the online Wrap Around Childcare Survey, which shows there is sufficient interest to take this to the next stage. Mrs Rye will be liaising with interested external providers.
- **2.** The KS1 playground project is now underway with children being involved in the planning. Photos will be taken and shared via the school newsletter.
- **3.** Term dates for 2020/2021 are currently being reviewed and will be passed onto parents when finalised.
- **4.** Concern was raised over the quality of the uniform and this will be reviewed by the Admin Team. Notification to go to all parents regarding the correct uniform to be worn during summer and winter months.
