Year 1 - Why does Easter matter to Christians? (Core learning)

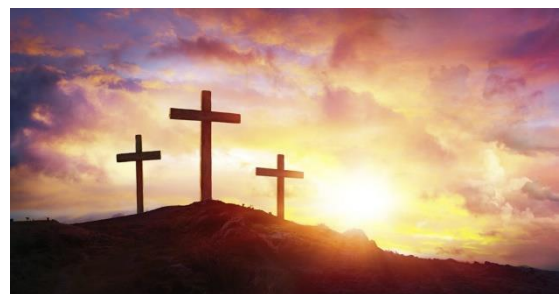
Year 2 - Why does Easter matter to Christians? (Digging deeper)
